# The Lord's Supper: an ecumenical pattern

#### Invitation to the Table

Come to this table, not because you must but because you may, not because you are strong, but because you are weak.

Come, not because any goodness of your own gives you a right to come, but because you need mercy and help.

Come, because you love the Lord a little and would like to love him more. Come, because he loves you and gave himself for you.

Come and meet the risen Christ, for we are his Body.

#### Confession

There may follow a prayer of confession, if one has not been offered earlier, or a prayer of preparation, such as

Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hidden: cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you, and worthily magnify your holy name; through Christ our Lord. Amen.

#### The Peace

Christ is our peace. He has reconciled us to God in one body by the cross. **We meet in his name and share his peace.** 

#### Institution

The Lord is here

His Spirit is with us

Lift up your hearts

We lift them to the Lord

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God

It is right to give our thanks and praise.

The apostle Paul tells us of the institution of the Lord's Supper: 1 Corinthians 11.23-26

# **Thanksgiving**

Eternal God, we praise you

for your creation of the world in all its richness and glory; for your great work of redemption in liberating the oppressed, renewing the weary and forgiving the sinful; for your calling of men and women to share in the work of salvation in the story of Israel and our story. And now we give you thanks for Jesus Christ our Lord, your word of love made flesh, who shared our humanity and revealed your grace. Therefore with angels and archangels, and with all the company of heaven, we proclaim your great and glorious name, for ever praising you and saying:

Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and might,
heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.

We thank you for his lifting up of the lowly, his healing of the broken and his death on the cross for the redemption of the world, of which this bread and cup are sign and symbol. We thank you for raising him to life and exalting him so that we might call him 'Lord', and follow in his way. We thank you for the gift of your Holy Spirit, for the fellowship of your church, and for all the means of grace and hope of glory. Living God, fill us with your Spirit, that, as we share this bread and wine, we might feed on the body and blood of Christ and be empowered for witness and service in your world. Accept our prayers and thanksgiving in the name of Jesus Christ, the light of the world and the life of your people. Amen.

Give us this day our daily bread,
and forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us.
